

## **Dr. Steven Were Omamo - Biography**



Dr. Steven Were Omamo is the Coordinator of Food Systems Strategy, Policy and Support and Deputy Director of Policy and Programme at the UN World Food Programme (WFP).

Dr. Omamo first joined WFP in 2006. He has served as Chief of Social Protection and Livelihoods, Chief of Food Security and Safety Nets, Deputy Director of Policy, Planning and Strategy, and Director of WFP Office and Representative to the African Union and UN Economic Commission for Africa, based in Addis Ababa.

Dr. Were Omamo also served as Director of Global Engagement and Research with the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD), Director of Policy and Advocacy with the Alliance for a Green Revolution in Africa (AGRA), Senior Research Fellow and Coordinator of the Eastern Africa Food Policy Network with the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI), Research Officer with the International Service for National Agricultural Research, Research Scientist with the International Livestock Research Institute (ILRI), Technical Advisor with both the Kenya Agricultural Research Institute (KARI) and the Association for Strengthening Agricultural Research in Eastern and Central Africa (ASARECA), and Lecturer at Egerton University, Kenya.

Dr. Omamo holds a BSc in Agribusiness from California State University, Fresno, an MSc in Agricultural Economics from the University of Connecticut, and an MA in International Development Policy and a PhD in Agricultural Economics from Stanford University.
